EXPOSITION OF THE HOLY SHROUD DUOMO DI SAN GIOVANNI BATTISTA

The exposition of the Holy Shroud begins on April 19th 2015 and ends on June 24th 2015, the feast of St. John the Baptist, patron saint of Turin.

OPENING OF THE NEW EGYPTIAN MUSEUM

You will be offered 10,000m2 in which the exhibits will be arranged in chronological sequence over four floors and shown in themed routes, all to be discovered. You can admire over 200 papyrus items along an 18m stretch, the Gallery of Sarcophaguses with 35 finely decorated pieces, including that of Kha. Then you can look in wonder at the three-dimensional glass display units holding some 3500 exhibits (divided by classes of different materials: wood, glass, ceramics) of the 50,000 owned, and also contemplate the ancient frescoes in the rooms of the 1st floor which resurfaced after 200 years beneath five coats of paint and are now restored. Valuable evidence of specific eras and places of ancient Egyptian history but, at the same time, the result of exploration, digging and acquisition. The promise is of an unforgettable journey, with the help of tablets and multimedia tables, in discovery of an ancient country like Egypt through the history of the museum which dates back to the 19th century, the antiquarian stage of 1824, and the Italian Archaeological Mission between 1900 and 1935 with the campaigns in Egypt.
